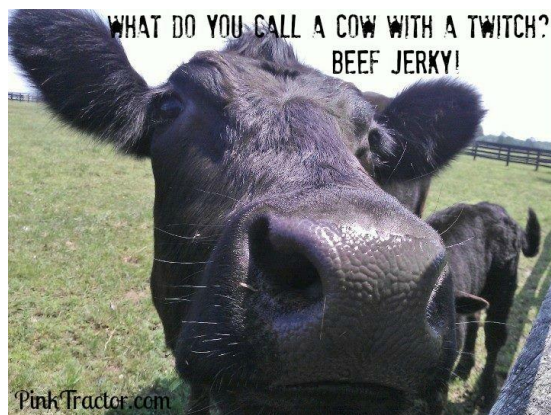
What is *Code Your World*?

Code Your World consists of one computer-based activity on Google's CS First platform, using MIT's Scratch programming language, and three unplugged activities that bring coding to life through games and interaction. It's perfect for first-time and beginner coders ranging in age from 8 to 14 and will teach kids important CS concepts problem-solving skills. Teachers and facilitators don't need any prior experience with computer science or coding to bring *Code Your World* to their students. Each activity is simple to facilitate and requires minimal preparation to deliver.
