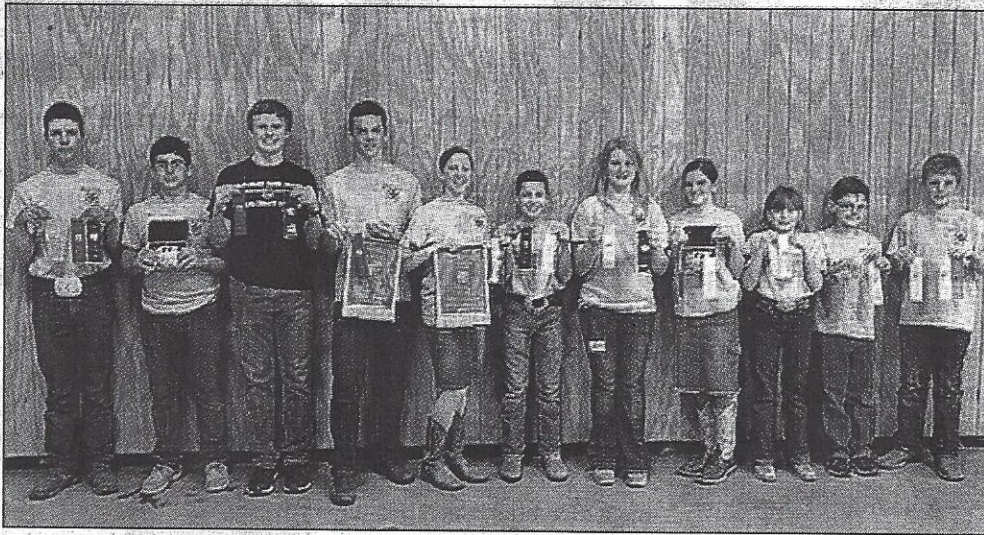


4-H Skillathon Teams Do Well

In the Livestock Skillathon Contest, participants identified meat cuts, equipment, feed stuffs, breeds and judged wool, meat and answered questions on animal health and feeding. The junior team earned 3rd place with Cooper Daniel 3rd overall. Other team members were Robbie Hendrickson and Abby Hammack. The intermediate team finished 1st with Sadie Bassham placing 1st and Ivey Bassham 3rd overall. Rilee Slaggle and Caleb Hammack both finished in the top 15 overall.
