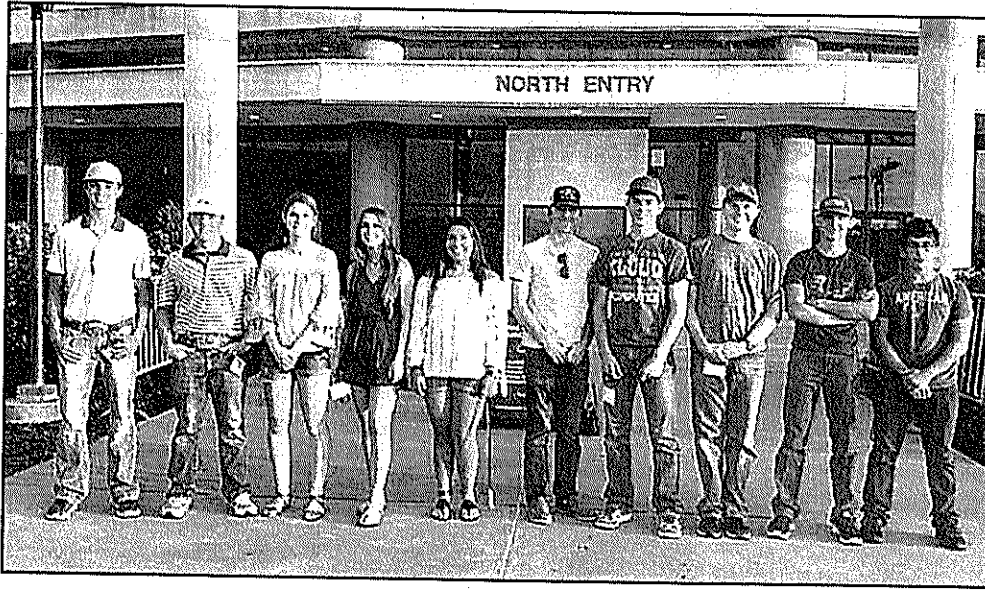


# Baylor County 4-H has Huge Success at State Roundup
