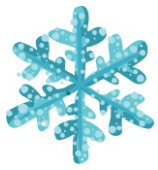
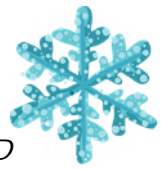

Important dates to Remember for 2022

MARCH - Steer VALIDATION Tags & STATE FAIR Sheep, Goat, and Swine will be ordered this month. Watch for emails or announcements on FACEBOOK.

JUNE -TURKEY orders will be taken this month. Watch for emails or announcements on FACEBOOK.

AUGUST - Sheep & Goat VALIDATION tags will be ordered this month. Watch for emails or announcements on FACEBOOK.

SEPTEMBER - COUNTY & STATE BROILERS Orders for will be taken this month. Watch for emails or announcements on FACEBOOK.

Beginning in 2022 there will be a \$2 processing fee added to each validation tag ordered.

All Exhibitors receive a BUYERS LIST *a few months after* BCLS. Those lists come to us, and we will send them out to you via email.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST show proof of THANK YOU NOTES before receiving their checks that are ready some time after May 1. You must show proof of notes before you put them in the mail.

Options for showing proof of THANK YOU NOTES written and mailed:

- 1) Bring your written, sealed, stamped notes to the Extension Office.
