

Clover Campaign Award Program

Clover Campaign money is used for camps or leadership opportunities. 4-H is an organization that helps facilitate the growth of leaders. We are trying to make "good citizens" and therefore, this money is to be used for those kids who are learning or growing in an area, in which they can return to their club or state, and disseminate that information (to help others grow as well).

General Rules:

- ~~1.) Must participate (once per session, i.e.: twice a year) in the Clover Campaign to be eligible for any funds.~~
- 2.) Must complete Clover Campaign Essay with Club Manager signature. By signing the club manager is stating that the youth participated in the Clover Campaign for the 2021-2022 year.
- 3.) Must turn in a flyer, pamphlet, etc. describing the event/activity with the essay application

This money will be awarded at the awards banquet in August in the form of a check to participants.

To be eligible for these funds, a youth must complete an essay with a prompt to be turned into the county office.

Essays potentially not sorted based on depth of essay, but rather the effort put into completing all aspects of the essay.

Priority will be given to those camps/leadership events in this order based on reach of impact: National level, state level, county level.

Application is due June 16th by 4:30 pm at the Extension Office. The Adult Officers will decide on recipients. Payment will be made at the awards banquet.
