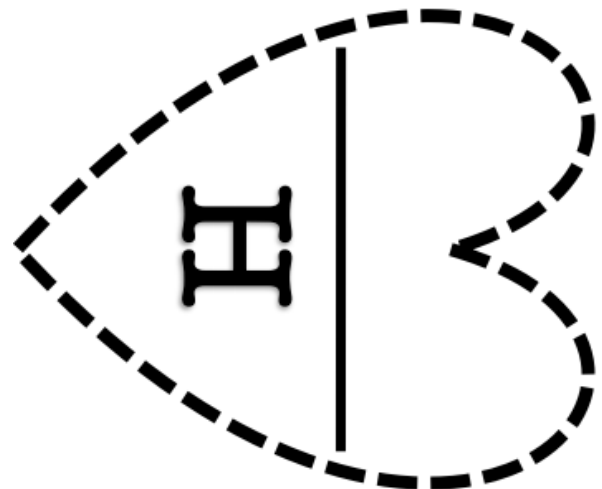
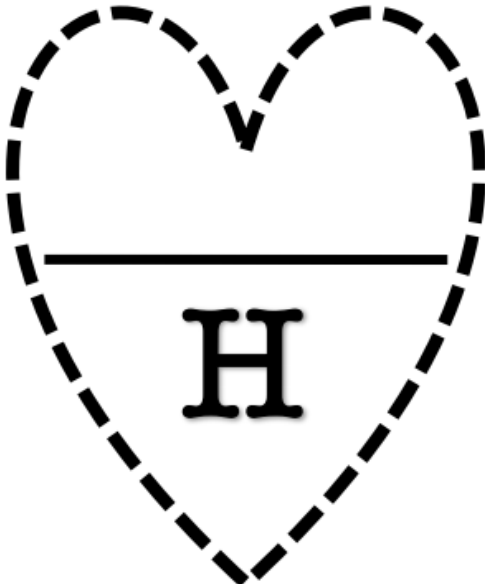
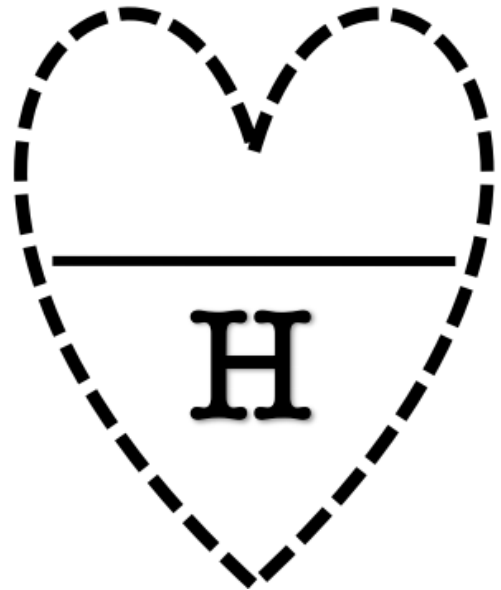
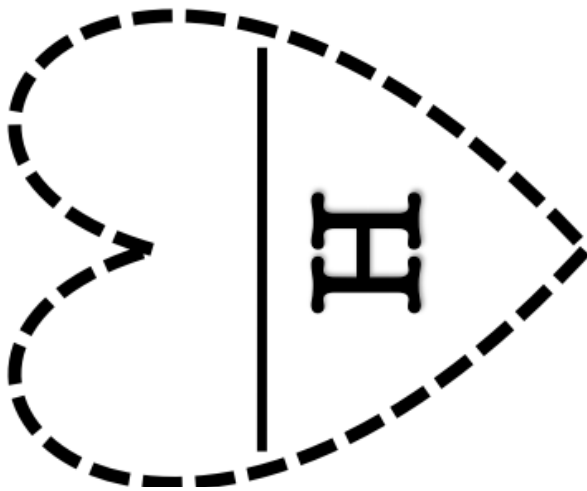


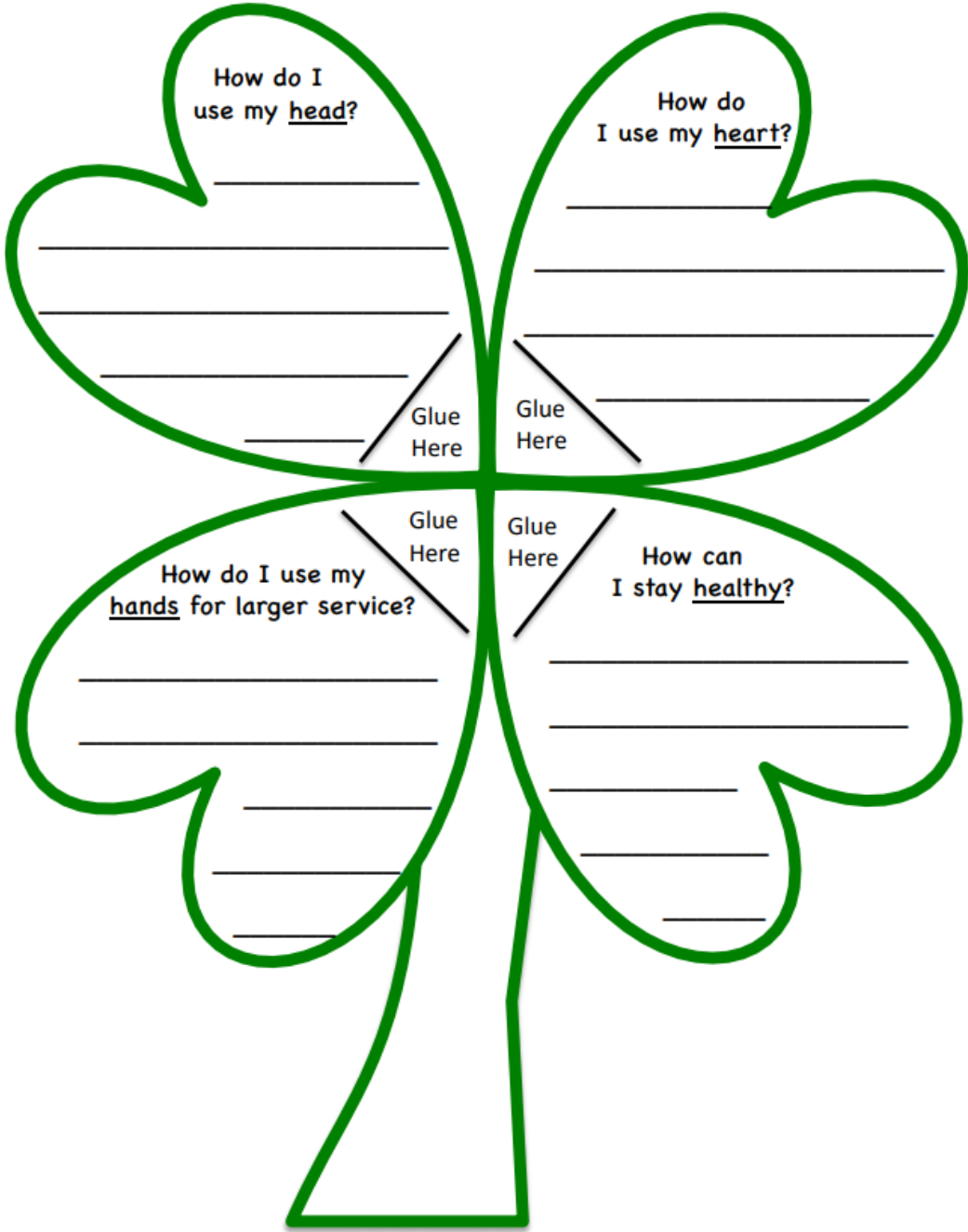
4-H Clover Craft Instructions

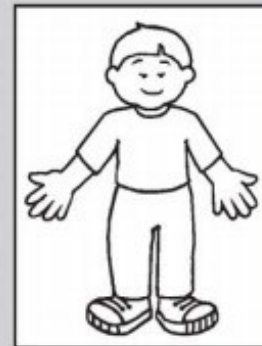
