### **What is a Liaison?**

A *Liaison* is a person who serves as a representative and messenger between groups of people or organizations by encouraging cooperation and the exchange of information.

#### **AGNR Project Coalition**

The AGNR Coalition is a partnership of youth and adults who help plan and implement activities and events under the Agriculture and Natural Resources Project areas of the 4-H & Youth Development Program in Cooke County. This is a collaborative effort between the 4-H and AG Agents in the county.

#### **Youth Advisory Board**

The Board was created to help the 4-H County Extension Agent determine what programs need to be implemented in the county year to year. Members represent youth from across the county. They review yearly educational impacts and outreach to new youth audiences and project areas. They help with extending educational services to clientele. They are spokespersons for the 4-H & Youth Development Program. Most importantly, they ensure that educational programs offered for youth are relevant.

#### **FCH Project Coalition**

The FCS Coalition is a partnership of youth and adults who help plan and implement activities and events under the Family and Community Health Project area of the 4-H & Youth Development Program in Cooke County. This is a collaborative effort between the 4-H and FCH Agents in the county.
