



Game of Clovers

1. Objective

- a. Increase county level participation and enrollment in the county 4-H program.
- b. Clubs will compete against one another to win the Game of Clovers by competing tasks as determined by the point system based on enrollment and participation.

2. Points system and rules

- a. Enrollment – clubs will earn points based on the percentage of enrolled members as compared to their historical enrollment numbers (based on the average of the 3 previous years). The earlier a club reaches 100% enrollment, the more points are received – see table below for point values. For each additional member enrolled after 100%, 5 points will be given. For new clubs in their first year with no historical enrollment numbers to average, their number will be calculated by averaging all club's historical enrollment numbers for the previous 3 years.
- b. Participation – clubs can earn points based on individual and club participation.
 - i. Individual participation – individual members can earn points for their club by participating in county-level events. For each event listed, a member can earn 10 points for their club written on the sign-in sheet. Events include: county level trainings/workshops/events, County Roundup, County Council meetings (not including County Council Officers), County recordbooks.
 - ii. Club participation – clubs will earn points for sign-in sheets submitted on the Game of Clovers page: <https://galveston.agrilife.org/4h/4-h-game-of-clovers/>. Submissions include club name, meeting date, and a photo/scan of the sign in sheet. Clubs will earn 15 points for the first sheet submitted each month, and 5 points for each additional sheet. All sign-in sheets must be submitted no later than the 10th of the following month of activity (ex: January's activities must be submitted by February 10th). Clubs will also earn 10 points for turning in club charter on time.

3. Awards

- a. Final points will be tallied in July in preparation for awards
 - i. Points will be awarded for participation and enrollment September 1 – June 30
- b. Award for the Game of Clovers Champion Club will be announced at the Awards Banquet
 - i. Winning club will be added to Game of Clovers plaque and will receive a prize at the beginning of the next 4-H year
- c. Runner-up raffle – the top 5 clubs*, excluding the first place club, will be put into a raffle drawing to receive a prize at the beginning of the next 4-H year.

*Clubs must meet 650 point minimum to be in the drawing.
