Heifers—exclusively Hereford cattle, health papers are not required for heifers to show, no limit to the number of heifers shown by one exhibitor, Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate for each animal at check in. The heifers must have been recorded through the Texas 4-H and FFA Heifer Validation in the name of the exhibitor by November 1, 2018. All cattle will be bedded on sand, no straw or hay may be used. Shavings may be used per facility manager.

Steers—exclusively Hereford Cattle from the State of Texas, each exhibitor is entitled to enter no more than 2 steers, an auction sale will be provided for approximately 25 junior steers, the Grand Champion steer must sell. The calves must exhibit purebred horned or polled Hereford characteristics and must have been fed and cared for by the exhibitor from the time of validation in June of 2018. Steers must weigh 850 lbs. and there is no maximum weight. 105% weigh back.

Lambs—exclusively Fine Wool lambs, wethers only, each exhibitor is limited to 4 lambs from the State of Texas, entries having shed lamb teeth or with permanent teeth in view are not eligible to show. Lambs must have been owned and cared for by the exhibitor from the time of validation in October of 2018. 100 lb. minimum; 3 lb. weigh back. Lambs must be shorn slick and with a uniform length of fleece. Boots may be left on lambs.

Goats— each exhibitor is limited to five goats from the state of Texas of any breed or crossbreeds in this show. Only wether goats may be shown. Goats must be shorn to 3/8" or less above the knee and hock joints, goats may have longer hair on end of the tail. There is a 50 lbs. minimum and no maximum weight. Goats must have been owned and cared for continuously since the time of validation in October by the exhibitor."

NOTE: If an exhibitor has shown an animal which was placed as a Grand Champion Steer, Wether Lamb, Wether Goat, or Barrow at Fort Worth, the exhibitor cannot center another animal in the same species in the Junior Division.

Lambs: Exhibitors may enter 8 wether lambs, but no more than 2 allowed in each weight class. 90 lbs. minimum weight for fine wool, fine wool cross, and medium wool; southdowns and Dorpers have an 80 lbs. minimum, no maximum. No tooth rule. All lambs must be shorn prior to arrival at Show. No electric clippers or blocking tables will be allowed in the Lamb barn. Exhibitors must have owned, fed, and cared for their lambs as of the validation date in October of 2018. **All champions and reserve champions must sell!**

Goats: Exhibitors may enter only 1 wether goat. Wether goats are required to have horns tipped blunt prior to arrival. All goats must be shorn to the skin with uniform clip above the knee and hock joints prior to arrival at the show. No electric clippers or blocking tables will be allowed in the Goat barn. Hand shears may be used. Minimum weight is 50 lbs. Exhibitors must have owned, fed, and cared for their goats as of the validation date in October of 2018. All weight Division Champions & Reserve Champions will sell in the Sale of Champions.

Barrows: Exhibitors may enter only 1 barrow. Exhibitor must have owned, fed, and cared for the barrow by the validation date in November of 2018. 230 lbs. minimum, 270 lbs. maximum. More than a 10 lb. weigh back will be disqualified. All champions and reserved champions will sell. **Terminal Show.**

Steers: Exhibitors may enter only 1 steer. Must have been owned, fed, and cared for by the exhibitor as of the date of validation in June. Minimum weight 900 lbs. Any steer weighing more than 105% of its official weight will be disqualified. Fans are NOT Allowed!!!!. NOTE: For 2020 show junior steers will have a minimum weight of 1,000 lbs.

Heifers: "Each exhibitor is entitled to enter one heifer. A copy of the original Registration Certificate must be submitted with Junior Heifer entries. Exhibitors must have original registration certificate available for inspection at check in. "Animals entered in this department must meet the respective breed association requirements and must be registered in the records of their respective breed association in the name of the exhibitor on or before November 1, 2018. Heifers must be validated with the Texas Heifer Validation Program."

Breeding Sheep: Exhibitors may show 2 animals in each of the single classes, but will be restricted to only 1 entry in each group class. See premium book for all tooth rules. "To be eligible for a group class, the animals must be entered and shown in a single class. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor prior to November 1, 2018, as evidence by the date of transfer to the breed association."

Passes: 1 complimentary pass per exhibitor.

Entry Fees - \$10.00 for county show. \$25.00 for District market and breeding entries; \$5.00 processing fee per exhibitor

Lambs - May enter 6 total with no more than 2 entries per breed. 100 lb minimum, 160 lb maximum, 85 lb minimum for Southdowns. Only wether lambs can be shown. 15 classes; no pre-set number of divided classes. Must be shorn slick from knee & hock up before arrival on the grounds. No powered clippers, blow dryers, trimming or blocking tables allowed on the grounds. Exhibitor must have possession and primary care of the animal throughout the feeding period and on feed at the time of validation in October.

Judges: County - Sterling Yurita, District - Kyle Smith

Goats - Each exhibitor may enter up to two goats. 60 lb minimum, 115 lb maximum. Wethers only. Must be disbudded or dehorned. All goats must be evenly slick shorn from the knees and hocks up prior to arrival on the grounds. No electric clippers or blow dryers will be allowed on the grounds. Goats with hair over 3/8" will be sifted. Any goats with signs of blocking, with adhesives of any kind or powder of any kind will be sifted. Shavings will be allowed in the meat goat barn. Exhibitor must have possession and primary care of the animal throughout the feeding period by the time of validation in October of 2018.

Judges: County - Sterling Yurita; District—Marty Gibbs

Barrows - May enter 6 total with no more than 2 entries per breed. 220 lb minimum, 280 lb maximum. Only barrows are eligible to show. Self-feeders and/or water trough/water apparatus will NOT be allowed. Will not have a preset number of divided classes. Exhibitor must have possession and primary care of the animal throughout the feeding period and on feed as of the validation date in November of 2019.

Judges: County - TBD, District - TBD

Steers - May enter 6 total with no more than 2 per breed. 950 lb minimum, no max. No British Crosses. No adhesives or trimming chutes allowed! Hay and shavings will be allowed in the barn. Steers with permanent teeth are allowed to show. Exhibitor must have possession and primary care of the animal throughout the feeding period prior to July 1, 2018. Only the state validation tag can be present in the animal's ear; no breeder's tags are allowed.

Judges: County - Mark Arnold, District - Dr. Chris Skaggs

Heifers - All registration papers must be submitted by 6:00 p.m. Thursday, January 17th. Exhibitor is allowed 2 entries per breed and no more than 6 per department. Must show ownership on or before November 1st of the previous year. No adhesives or trimming chutes allowed! Use of adhesives or trimming chutes will result in disqualification of the exhibitor and animals. Finishing clippers are allowed. Generators will be allowed in designated areas only. Hay and shavings will be allowed in the barn.

Judges: County - Mark Arnold, District—Dr. Chris Skaggs

Angoras - Commercial: May enter 2 per class. A group will consist of 3 goats of the same class & must submit a separate entry. Must show ownership on or before November 1st of the previous year. Must be machine shorn on or after August 1 of the previous year. Must have a ranch ear mark made with either a knife or ear notcher.

Judges: County—TBA, District—Andy Laughlin

Registered: May enter 2 per class. All registration papers must be submitted between 3:00 - 6:00 p.m. Sunday, January 13th; registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor. Must show ownership on or before November 1st of the previous year. Must be machine shorn on or after August 1 of the previous year. Must show 2 of the 3 accepted methods of identification.

Judges: County—TBA, District—Andy Laughlin

Breeding Sheep—Registered: May enter 2 per class. Registration papers must be submitted upon arrival on the grounds. Ownership must have taken place by October 1, 2018. Medium Wool Breeds, Hair Sheep, Southdowns, and Dorper-All sheep must have been slick-shorn, with the exception of boots, within one week prior to the show. See full guidelines on shearing and tooth rules in the HCDJLS Catalog.

Judges : County - Jason Marek, District—Burk Lattimore

Breeding Gilts - May enter 3 per breed but no more than 6 per department in the registered show; limit to 3 entries in the non-pedigreed show. Minimum weight of 200 lbs. for the non-pedigreed show. Animals must be registered in the Herdbook of their Association in only the name of the junior owner on or before December 1, the year preceding the show. Non-pedigreed (cross) and pedigreed gilts must be tagged with an official Texas Swine Tag. Pedigreed gilt classes are for animals farrowed between JULY 1 and SEPTEMBER 10 of the previous year. There will be a 15 pound weigh-back on both the top and bottom. If a gilt does not weigh within 15 pounds of turned in weight, it will be disqualified. A gilt can only be entered in the Registered Breeding division or the Non-Pedigreed division, not both. Registration papers must be turned in by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 13th for district show.

CTBR ONLY

Texas' Elite Showcase is open to only gilts of the Certified Texas Bred Registry. The gilts must have been bred, farrowed, and raised in Texas and have a valid CTBR certificate. CTBR certificates are furnished to eligible breeders; exhibitors should request the certificate from the breeder of the gilt.

STATE VALIDATED – OWNERSHIP DEADLINE BY DECEMBER 1

All gilts entered in Texas' Elite Showcase must be validated in the Texas 4-H and FFA Swine Validation Program. Gilts must be listed on an official Swine Validation Form between November 1 and November 30. Exhibitors must have owned and cared for their animals continuously since November 30, 2018.

There is no limit on the number of entries each exhibitor may enter, provided each entry meets all requirements.

CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

Health papers are required on all gilts and will be inspected upon arrival. All certificates of veterinary inspection must be issued on or after January 11, 2019, with the following information:

- *Leptospirosis vaccination is required on breeding swine within 30 days prior to date of the sale with vaccine containing the following strains: Canicola, Hardjo, Icterohaemorrhagiae, Grippotyphosa and Pomona. Vaccination date must appear on the health certificate.*
- *A statement must appear that says the animal has not been fed garbage, has not been exposed to hog cholera or pseudorabies, does not originate from a quarantined herd, nor has the herd of origin had PRV within the last six months, nor have the entries themselves been vaccinated for PRV.*
- *Gilt identification must be included on health certificates in the form of validation number and ear notches.*

PEDIGREED (PUREBRED) DIVISION

The breeder's name listed on the certificate must match the breeder's name listed on the official registration certificate issued by the breed association. Exhibitors will be required to present original registration certificates, which indicate the gilt to be Texas-bred. Photocopies will not be accepted. Animals must be registered in the herd book of their association in the name of the junior owner. All purebred gilts must be eligible for exhibition as per guidelines established by their respective breed associations. A committee of three appointed by the show will determine the eligibility of those gilts that exhibit questionable breed character as established by the breed association for exhibition. All purebred gilts are subject to DNA testing to determine stress, color gene and parentage.

Purebred classes will be broken by age following check-in. Gilts must have been farrowed between July 1 – September 20, 2018. Classes will be broken as evenly as possible within breed according to birthdate. Purebreds will follow an 8 breed format, with the following breeds being eligible: Berkshire, Chester, Duroc, Hampshire, Landrace, Poland China, Spotted, Yorkshire.

NON-PEDIGREED (CROSSBRED) DIVISION

Classes will be broken by weight following the weight card deadline. Gilts will be divided into three divisions by weight – Light, Medium and Heavy. Classes will be divided as evenly as possible. Non-pedigreed gilt must weigh a minimum of 230 pounds, with a maximum weight of 350. Weight cards must be turned in by 10:00AM, February 9. There will be a 10-pound weigh-back on both the top and bottom. If a gilt does not weigh within 10 pounds of the submitted weight, the gilt will be disqualified.

Exhibitors of crossbred gilts will be required to complete a pedigree form at time of check-in, listing the sire and sire of dam.

Lambs: May enter 1 wether lamb. Lambs must be state validated. Must be shorn slick to the skin above knee and hock joints before arrival. Lambs must weigh between 100 –175 lbs. There will be a 5 lb. weigh-back. No pre-set weight breaks. All placing lambs must sell at auction.

Goats: May enter 1 wether goat. Must be state validated. Horns must be blunt tipped before arrival. Must weigh between 60lbs. & 115 lbs. inclusive. 4 lb. weigh back at time of judging. Must be shorn slick, with no indication of blocking, to the skin above knee and hock joints, to include the head, excluding tail switch, before arrival. All placing goats must sell at auction.

Barrows: May enter 1 barrow. Must be state validated. Must weigh between 240 lbs. and 280 lbs. All barrows penned for placing consideration will be re-weighed. 10 lb. weigh-back. No pre-set weight breaks. All placing barrows must sell at auction.

Steers: May enter 1 per exhibitor. Must be state validated. Minimum show weight is 1000 lbs and maximum show weight is 1500 lbs. Steers will be weighed at the time of judging, steers weighing greater than or less than 5% of the weigh-in weight will be disqualified. Steers must be dehorned, polled, or scurred. Scurs/horn growth must not exceed 3 inches from the base of the head. Must have 1/4" or less hair except on the tail switch upon arrival on the grounds. Not required to have both temporary central incisors in place. All placing steers must sell in the Junior Market Steer Auction.

Breeding Boer & Angora Goats: Exhibitors may show as many as two (2) animals in each single class. Angora goats will be shown by the age on the Registration Certificate. For Boer goats, the age listed on the Registration Certificate will be used to determine class divisions. Only ABGA Original Registration Certificates will be accepted for the Junior Boer Breeding Goat Show. Angora goats must be machine shorn to the skin on or after August 1, 2018. The clipping of Boer goats will be left to the discretion of the exhibitor. Angora goats must be registered in youth owner's name by November 1, 2018. Boer goats must be registered in the owner's name by October 1, 2018. Breeding Boer goats must be state validated. Angora goats are not required to be state validated.

Breeding Sheep: Ewes must be re-validated each year preceding the show, must have legible ear ID number corresponding to registration certificate. Exhibitors may show as many as two (2) animals in each single class. Must show ownership on or before Oct. 1st, 2018. Sheep will be shown according to tooth development (*see premium book for full description of tooth rules*). See premium book for shearing guidelines. Must be state validated.

Junior Wether Dam Show: Must be state validated. Ewes must be re-validated each year preceding the show. Show is intended to be an exhibition for ewes suited for club lamb production. Ewes are not required to be registered. Each exhibitor may show as many as two (2) animals in each single division. Ewes may not double enter in the Junior Breeding Sheep Show and this show. Junior Wether Doe Show: Each owner may show as many as 2 animals in each division. Does are not required to be registered. Does may not double enter in the Junior Boer Breeding Goat Show and the Junior Wether Does Show. Animals must be state validated. Does must be shorn slick to the skin above knee and hock joints prior to arrival. Does will be shown according to tooth development. Minimum weight is 50 lbs.

Breeding Heifers: Exhibitors may enter one breeding beef heifer. This is a "Blow & Go" show. Must show ownership on or before Nov. 1st, 2018. Must be state validated. Use Premium Book to determine classes on entry forms.

Purebred Breeding Gilts: Each owner may exhibit up to 2 breeding gilts. Open to gilts only. Gilts may not double enter in the Junior Gilt Show and the Junior Crossbred Gilt Show. Must show ownership on or before Dec. 1st, 2018. All gilts must have been farrowed between July 1st and September 10, 2018.

Crossbred Breeding Gilts: 1 entry per exhibitor. Gilts must be state validated. All gilts qualifying for the auction will be required to sell. Crossbred gilt show is intended to be an exhibition of gilts suited for club pig production. Minimum weight is 230 lbs. and max 340 lbs.

Broilers: Exhibitors may enter 1 pen of 3 broilers. Each exhibitor is required to bring two containers (each 16oz. or smaller) for feed. Exhibitors may bring their own feed. The top 35 placing broiler pens will be sold in the auction. Terminal Show.

Turkeys: Exhibitors may enter 1 turkey hen and 1 turkey tom. Each exhibitor is required to bring two containers (each 16oz. or smaller) for feed. Exhibitors may bring their own feed. The top 35 placing turkey hens will be sold in the auction. Terminal Show.

Texas Stars Doe Show: Limit of 3 entries per exhibitor. All does must be state validated. Animal must have been under the care of the youth owner by October 31, 2018. Health papers will be required. The only tags does may have in their ears are state validation and scrapie tags. "Does must weigh a minimum of 50 lbs, and there is no maximum. At the time of show, does must not possess more than their first set of yearling teeth." Horns should be tipped and rounded. Hair may not exceed 1.25 inches above the hock and knees.

Junior Ewe Lamb Futurity: An exhibitor may initially start with as many as four registered or commercial Finewool ewes, but is allowed to show only one pair of ewe lambs. Health papers are required. Sawdust is provided free of charge and shavings are available to purchase. No outside shavings are allowed. **Terminal Show.**

Barrows: Exhibitors may enter 1 barrow. Must be State Validated. Each breed will be divided into weight groups and a judge will select the top 664 barrows for premium sale. Minimum Weight is 240 lbs and 280 lbs maximum. Exhibitors are not allowed to bring in outside shavings. Sawdust will be provided. All barrows selected by the judge will be weighed before re-entering the arena. See premium book for weigh-back guidelines. **Terminal Show.**

Steers: Exhibitors may enter 1 steer. Steers must be State Validated. Minimum weight 1000 lbs. All Placing steers will be weighed before leaving the ring. 95-105% weigh back. Lambs: May enter 1 wether lamb. All tags except the Texas Validation Tag and/or the Texas Lamb Breeders tag must be removed. Lambs are not required to have milk teeth in place. 5 lbs. weigh-back for all 1st & 2nd placing animals as well as random animals. Minimum show weights are 100lbs. (except Southdown and Dorper lambs which are 90lbs) and no maximum weights. Lambs must be shorn slick to the skin above knee and hock joints before arrival. Classes will be determined after all weights have been turned in, and classes may be grouped by 3lb spreads. All placing lambs will sell in the Youth Auction. Exhibitors must feed and care for their animals as of the validation date in October of 2018. Terminal show.

Goats: Exhibitor limited to 1 wether goat. All tags except Texas validation tag must be removed. Goats must weigh between 60-120 lbs. Goats are not required to have milk teeth in place. Must be shorn slick to the skin above knee and hock joints, excluding the tail switch. Horns must be blunt tipped. 4lb. Weigh-back for all 1st, 2nd, & random placing goats. Classes will be determined after all weights have been turned in, and classes may be grouped by 3lb spreads. All placing market goats will sell in the Youth Auction. Exhibitor must feed and care for their animal as of the validation date in October of 2018. Terminal Show.

Barrows: Exhibitor limited to one barrow. Barrows must weigh between 240 to 280 lbs. Classes will be determined after all weights have been turned in and classes may be grouped by 3lb spreads. All placing barrows will sell in the Youth Auction. 10 lbs weigh-back on all placing barrows. Exhibitor must feed and care for their animals as of validation in November of 2018. New for 2019...Crossbreds will have two divisions, light and dark.

Steers: Exhibitor limited to 1 steer entry. All tags except for the Texas validation tag must be removed. Steers are NOT required to have temporary central incisors in place. Steers hair may not exceed 1/4" on any part of the body excluding the tail switch and must be shorn before arrival. Minimum weight 1000 lbs and no maximum. Steers that weigh more than 5% above the weigh-in weight will be disqualified. **All placing steers MUST sell in the Junior Market Steer Auction.** Animals must be fed by and cared for by the exhibitor as of the validation date in June of 2018. Terminal show for placing steers.

Heifers: Each owner may enter a maximum of 2 heifers. Health papers will be required for all animals. Original registration certificates will be used to verify ownership date. The following breed divisions will be offered: Angus, Beefmaster, Brahman, Brangus, Charolais, Hereford, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Red Angus, Red Brangus, Santa Gertrudis, Shorthorn, Simbrah, Simmental, ARB, & ORB. Exhibitor ownership by November 1, 2018.

Poultry: Exhibitor limited to 1 turkey (hen or tom) and/or 3 broilers. The sexes will be shown separately in the broiler division. Rodeo Austin will now have a separate hatch for broilers; they will no longer be ordered with Houston broilers. Exhibitors may show one pen of either sex in the broiler division. Exhibitor is required to supply their own feed and two 1 lb. coffee cans per entry. Electrolytes may be used in water. Self-contained, battery-operated fans are permitted. Terminal show.
