

Robot Check Out Kit Policy

Flat check out fee = \$25.00 / per youth on team

Requirements for Using Gillespie 4H Lego® Mindstorm EV3 Kits

- 4H Enrollment – All Youth Working with Robot Kit of Parts Must Be Enrolled in 4H Before Checking Out Kit
- Adult Volunteers Working With You Must Be Enrolled in 4H as approved volunteers
- Time Period to Check Out Kits is typically 6-7 weeks prior to a competition

The materials in a check-out kit include:

- LEGO Mindstorms Core Set
- LEGO Mindstorms Expansion Set
- Laptop
- *"The Art of Lego Mindstorms EV3 Programming"* book
- large black storage container on wheels (optional) - these are handy and helpful, but they are large and will not fit in the trunk of a car
- plastic tub to carry robot in

Please bring kits back in good shape. This includes but is not limited to cords with laptop, pieces disassembled and placed in trays in an organized manner.

Please do not mix any pieces from home with this kit even if a competition allows it without approval from the Extension Office.

NOTE: laptops do not turn off just by closing them; you have to tell them to shut down to turn them off! Also, you won't want Windows updates if at all possible because there is not enough space on the laptop to handle most of them.

If any equipment is brought back in damaged condition, the replacement fees are as follows:

- Laptop = \$450.00
- USB to Micro USB Cord = \$5.00
- Core Set with robot brick = \$412.00
- Expansion Set = \$110.00
- The art of LEGO Mindstorms EV3 Programming Book = \$28.00
