7) Why do you want to be a Gillespie 4-H County Council officer?

If elected each Council Officer is required to attend 80% of Gillespie County Council Officer and County Council meetings as well as the county council officer retreat July 28 – 30, 2022. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in the inability to run for a county council officer position in 2023 – 2024. If elected Gillespie County Council Officers are expected to attend D-10 leadership lab, Gillespie 4-H new member night, 4-H kick-off night, support Gillespie 4-H week activities, lead 2022 – 2023 Gillespie 4-H banquet, and support other activities as asked throughout the year where County Council is asked to represent the Gillespie County 4-H program.
