NOTE: As per Title 12 Section 1951.056 of the Occupational Code, registered beekeepers are permitted to conduct bee removals when doing so in accordance with aforementioned section. The Bee Removal Transportation Permit allows beekeepers to transport removed colonies across county lines. As an added service to both the beekeeper and the general public Texas Apiary Inspection Service will post a list of beekeepers who have this permit on the web site txbeeinspection.tamu.edu. This permit will expire on August 31 of each year at which time it will have to be renewed.
