



- 1 small bag tortilla chips
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1 can Rotel tomatoes with chilies
- 1 chicken
- 1/2 cup chicken broth
- 2 cups cheddar cheese, grated
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup

Season and stew chicken. Bone and cut into pieces. Butter casserole and line with tortilla chips. Layer chicken, onion, sauce (soups, Rotel tomatoes, & chicken broth). Repeat, ending with chips and cheese. Bake 350 degrees for one hour. Recipe by Carol Williamson

Sour Cream Enchiladas

3 cans cream of chicken soup

1 can green chili enchilada

1 lb. Longhorn cheese, shredded

1 lb. Monterrey Jack Cheese, shredded

2 (8 oz.) ctn. Sour cream

1 can green chilies, chopped

2 bunches green onion tops, chopped

Flour tortillas

Mix together soup, enchilada sauce, sour cream, green chilies and set aside. Heat flour tortillas until soft. Spoon soup mix into tortillas along with cheese and onions and roll up. Put leftover soup and cheese on top and bake 350 degrees until hot and bubbly. Recipe by: Carol Coggin
