“I Dare You” Leadership Award

Criteria for Selection:

1. The 4-H member must be no older than 18 nor younger than 14 as of January 1st of the prior year.
2. The 4-H member must submit an **awards program record book** in the year he or she is to be considered for the Harrison County Leadership Award.
3. The member must have participated in three or more of the following activities:
 - Method Demonstration
 - Project Exhibits
 - Citizenship Activities
 - Public Relations (speech, club exhibit, radio, TV, newspaper, special projects, National 4-H Week)
 - Camps
 - Completion of projects on a county level
4. The 4-H member must have participated in a community service activity.
5. The 4-H member must actively hold positions of leadership on the club and county levels.
6. 4-H member must have participated in the county 4-H program for 3 years.
