District Horse Show Deadlines

The District Horse Show will be held Tuesday, June 18th and Wednesday, June 19th at the Tyler Rose Horse Park in Tyler, Texas. Entries for this show are due Friday, May 17th and must be done on 4-H Connect.

Validating Your Horse for District - Deadline April 15th and costs \$10 per horse. Late validation can be done until May 1st for \$20 per horse.

Validating your horse(s) for the show will be done online again this year. Every horse shown will be validated through the 4-H Connect system.



You will need to upload your registration papers (if your horse is registered), coggins and photos of your horse when completing the validation process. You will need one photo of the front, one photo of the left side and one photo of the right side. Make sure that the entire horse in the picture or you will have to redo your pictures. Please have your horse validated online before April 15th in case you have problems with the system. If you need help, please let the Extension office staff know and we will help you.
