If you would like to show broilers at the State Fair of Texas, please let our office know by Monday, June 19th by calling 903-675-6130 or emailing Angela achemphill@ag.tamu.edu . Chicks are \$1.25 each with a minimum of 25 ordered max of 75. Only 2 pens can be entered at the State Fair by one exhibitor. Siblings cannot share birds. The date for the broiler show is Monday, October 2nd, and entries will be due to the Extension office mid August. This is a terminal show. The birds will be picked up from A&M on August 22nd. If we have enough families order, we can arrange for one person to pick them up. If not, you may be responsible for picking up your broilers from A&M.

Rules:

1. All participants must be 4-H members enrolled via 4-H Connect.
2. \$25 one time tournament entry fee. Participants may enter one or all events. There will be 3 events: June 10, June 17, and June 24.
3. An item of the day will be posted on Facebook before 5pm day 1.
4. Catch up to a daily bag limit of catfish during event hours and post them between 6pm day 1 and 6pm day 2. No more than 30 catfish will count.

Channel, Blue, their hybrids & subspecies.

Daily bag: 25 in any combination, Minimum length: 12 inches.

Flathead

Daily bag: 5, Minimum length: 18 inches.

5. Minimum lengths will be used. Channels, blues, yellow/flatheads and hybrids will need to be measured on a Check-it-Stick if they are smaller than 24 inches.
6. Big fish should be measured on a 6 ft. 2 x 4 or 2 x 6. Measure the fish on the 2 by first and mark it with a pen or pencil, place fish next to the board, then use tape measure on the board. Item of the day should also be in the photo. Measurement must be readable in the photo.
7. Those catching the most and largest legal catfish will win. Judges will have the final say on fish size for those that are not measured. Winners will be announced at the end of each event and then overall.
8. Photo with Catfish and item of the day must be posted to the District 5 Facebook page during the event times. Posting before 6pm day 1 or after 6pm day 2 will not count. State laws must be followed.
9. We encourage participants to fish with a buddy or as a club. Fishermen must be supervised at all times for safety reasons.
10. Rosettes/Medals awarded to 1st thru 5th place for each event.
