Scholarship Guidelines / Details

- Current 4-H Member of any chartered Henderson County 4-H Club, in good standing, with a minimum of 3 years active membership.
- Emphasis will be on 4-H involvement, participation, and leadership activities
- Youth must have completed three Record Books, at least two should be 4-H Senior Division Record Books. Extension Staff will verify Record Books. Most recent must be turned in with application.
- Applicants may apply during their senior year of High School.
- Minimum GPA of 2.5, in addition to SAT or ACT test scores.
- Youth will present three letters of recommendation with application. (Recommendations should be from someone who has worked with the youth and not an immediate family member.) No recommendation shall be from the County Extension Staff.
- Interviews will be conducted first week of May.
- May be awarded to applicants applying or attending college or vocational (trade) school.
- Number of Scholarships will be up to 3 for a total amount of \$1500. Scholarships will range from \$500 to \$1500.
 - If (3) eligible applicants are chosen by the committee, each will receive \$500;
 - If (2) eligible applicants are chosen by the committee, each will receive \$750;
 - If (1) eligible applicant is chosen by the committee, he/she will receive \$1500;
- Money will be sent directly to institution
 - Recipients are required to provide school contact name & phone number, school address, student ID number, class schedule, and transcript when requested
- Date of issuance you have 1 year to claim the scholarship
- Scholarship may be presented at High School Awards Banquet or program by a member of ALPA or County Extension staff. Counselor needs to be notified of the scholarship.
