- 1. All 4-H Clubs and FFA Chapter that are eligible to participate in the Henderson County Livestock Show may have contestants in the Queen and Princess Contests
- 2. Queen Contestants must be 14 through 19 years of age and Princess Contestants must be 8 and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or 9, years of age though 13 years of age as of August 31. The queen and Princess will be selected for poise, interview, personality, speaking, and journal (which will be provided).
- 3. Entry Forms are due by February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Obtain applications form the association secretary. Send entries to princess/queen contest superintendent. You can send with your entries or to the extension office.
- 4. Entry fee is \$25.00.
- 5. There will be three practice sessions. Contestants will meet and will be able to ask questions and pick up notebook.
- 6. The Queen and Princess must be present at all contests for awards presentations and help in other activities as she is asked to do so by the Livestock Show, represent the Livestock

- Show Association in fairs, rodeos, parades, etc. throughout the year, when possible, and be present for the crowning of the Following year's winners.
- 7. Current princess/ queen and all contestants will be required to work during the HCLS Premium Auction. Any absences must have board approval in advance. Any contestants absent without board approval will be disqualified.
- 8. Previous winners are ineligible
- 9. Judges for Queen/ Princess contest must not reside in Henderson County unless approved by the board.
