Market Lamb Show

1. All market lambs will be weighed.
 2. Finewool, Finewool Cross, Southdown, Hair Sheep, Medium Wool
 3. There will be a 4 pound weigh back on the top 4 placing lambs.
 4. Lambs must have milk teeth.
 5. Wethers and/or ewe lambs may be shown.
 6. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor can enter.
- Substitute exhibitors are allowed in the case of multiple entries within same class only.

Market Goat Show

1. Market Goats will show 15 minutes after the conclusion of the Market Lamb Show.
 2. All goats will be weighed.
 3. There will be a 4 pound weigh back on the top 4 placing goats in each Class.
 4. Wethers and/or does must have milk teeth at the time of show.
 5. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor can enter.
- Substitute exhibitors are allowed in the case of multiple entries within same class only.

GROOMING RULES: BLOW and SHOW

Animals are to be shown in natural conformation and color. Grooming materials leaving any kind of residue are not permitted. Hair in all locations must be capable of being combed.

Heifer Show

1. Heifers will be shown in three (3) Breed Divisions:
American, British, and Exotic.
2. Division Champions will compete for overall Grand & Reserve Champion.
3. All heifers must arrive and be checked in by 12:30 p.m.
4. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor can enter in each class.
5. Substitute exhibitors are allowed in the case of multiple entries within same class only.
6. Heifers will be shown by age as of show day.
Age Classes are: Class 1; less than 1 year; Class 2; 1-2 years

Steer Show

1. Steers will be shown in three (3) Breed Divisions:
American, British, and Exotic.
2. Division Champions will compete for overall Grand & Reserve Champion.
3. Steers shall not weigh more than 105% of original weight turned in.
4. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor can enter in each class.
Substitute exhibitors are allowed in the case of multiple entries within same class only.

Miniature Hereford Show

1. Only steers and heifers may be shown.
2. Steers & heifers will show together.
3. Classes will be broken by weight.
4. All animals in this show must not exceed a height of 48”.
5. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor can enter in each class. Substitute exhibitors are allowed in the case of multiple entries within same class only.
