(Grades 3-5)

ROOKIE RECORD BOOK:

To recognize the best rookie Junior Record Book. 4-H members may receive this award only once.

Requirements:

- First year completing a Record Book
- Complete an application
- Submit a record book

OUTSTANDING JUNIOR:

To recognize outstanding effort of 4-H members. 4-H members may receive this award only once.

Requirements:

- Complete an application

BRONZE STAR:

To recognize outstanding achievements by junior 4-H members. 4-H members may receive the award only once.

Requirements:

- 4-H member for at least one year
- Complete an application
- Submit a record book
- Attend an interview

INTERMEDIATE AWARDS

(Grades 6-8)

ROOKIE RECORD BOOK:

To recognize the best rookie Intermediate Record Book. 4-H members may receive this award only once.

Requirements:

- First year completing a Record Book
- Complete an application
- Submit a record book

OUTSTANDING INTERMEDIATE:

To recognize outstanding effort of 4-H members. 4-H members may receive this award only once.

Requirements:

- Complete an application

SILVER STAR:

To recognize outstanding achievements by intermediate 4-H members. 4-H members may receive this award only once.

- 4-H member for at least two years
- Complete an application
- Submit a record book
- Attend an interview

SENIOR AWARDS

(Grades 9-12)

ROOKIE RECORD BOOK:

To recognize the best rookie Senior Record Book. 4-H members may receive this award only once.

Requirements:

- First year completing a Record Book
- Complete an application
- Submit a record book

OUTSTANDING SENIOR:

To recognize outstanding effort of 4-H members. 4-H members may receive this award only once.

Requirements:

- Complete an application

GOLDEN CLOVER:

To recognize outstanding achievements by a 4-H member who has already been a Gold Star recipient. Same requirements as Gold Star listed on next page.

NATIONAL DANFORTH "I DARE YOU" AWARD:

To recognize senior 4-H members for outstanding character. 4-H members may receive this award only once. Same requirements as Gold Star listed on next page.

GOLD STAR:

To recognize senior 4-H members for outstanding achievement. The Gold Star Award is the highest achievement award at the county level. Counties have award quotas based on the number of senior 4-H members.

Requirements:

- At least 15 years old as of September 1st of the current year
- 4-H member for at least three years
- Submit a record book
- Completed projects in three different project areas
- Participated in one or more activities in at least three of the following areas:
 - Method Demonstration/4-H Presentations
 - Contests
 - Project Exhibits
 - Camps
 - Leadership Lab
 - Citizenship Activities
 - Public Relations (for example: demonstrations, speeches, poster displays, club exhibits, project shows, radio, TV, newspapers, special projects)
 - Other (may include exchange programs, fund-raising, State and National Congress, etc.)
 - Note- These may have been accomplished over the member's entire 4-H career.
- Exhibited leadership skills:
 - Serving as a 4-H officer or committee chairman (club, county, district or state)
 - And/or as a junior or teen leader in an activity or project with or under the supervision of an adult volunteer leader.
- Participated in at least one community service activity:
 - Working with junior 4-H members
 - Projects either individual, club, or county
 - Motivated other 4-H members through participation in projects
