Sew Much Fun Field Trip

For the May Sew Much Fun sewing session, we will be traveling to The Sewing Studio, 4601 S. Loop 289, in Lubbock.

Sewing Tip: *Cleaning Your Sewing Machine*

Tools needed: Long Tweezer, Small Brush, Disc Shape Screwdriver, Sewing Machine Manual (all of these items should have come with your machine.)

1. Turn off and unplug your machine.
2. Raise needle to "up" position.
3. Remove needle and pressure foot holder.
4. Slide your flat bed attachment off and the needle plate cover towards you to remove.
5. Grab the small brush and tweezers and CLEAN AWAY!!!!
6. If your machine has a removable bobbin basket, take this out and clean it and the area around it. (You may want to take a picture first before disassembling.)
7. Unscrew the needle plate and repeat the cleaning process in this area.
8. Now, it's time to put everything back together. (You will be glad you took that picture!)
9. To keep your machine in top working order, put in a new needle.
10. Wipe down the surface of your machine with a soft cloth dipped in a neutral detergent. Give the machine one more pass with a fresh dry cloth.
