## Following 4-H Awards Involve an Application & Interview Process:

**Bronze Star Awards:** Applicant Age- All 4-H members that were in the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, or 5<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2018-2019 school year (junior age youth)

**Silver Star Awards:** Applicant Age- All 4-H members that were in the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, or 8<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2018-2019 school year (intermediate age youth) Must have completed 2 years in 4-H.

**Gold Star Awards (Highest County 4-H Achievement Award):** Applicant Age- Applicant that was in the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2018-2019 school year (senior age youth) Must have completed 3 years in 4-H.

**Danforth, I Dare You Award:** Applicant Age- Applicant that was in the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2018-2019 school year (senior age youth) Must have completed 3 years in 4-H.

**All applications are due to CEO by June 22, 2020 with 4-H Record book.  
Interviews will be conducted on June 24, 2020 at Extension Office.**
