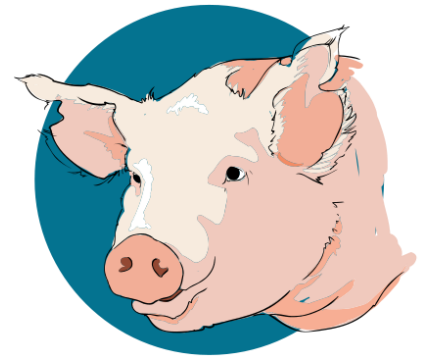


## Important Validation Information!

### All gilts showing in the 2019 State Fair Youth Purebred Gilt Show must be validated.

Animals must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor(s)\* no later than June 30 of the current year. Registration papers must be uploaded to the validation website by July 15, 2019.

\*Gilts for the 2019 State Fair of Texas Youth Purebred Gilt Show may be family registered and validated (ex. Jane, John, James Smith) provided all owners/exhibitors are individually listed and eligible. For eligibility, all owners/exhibitors must be members of a Texas 4-H Club or Texas FFA Chapter (except where stated otherwise) who have continuously owned and personally fed and cared for their animal under the direct supervision of a CEA or AST. Exhibitors must be enrolled in, and attending, public, private or home school elementary or secondary schools in Texas and they must be at least 8 years old and in the third grade, but not more than 18 years old on September 1. Exhibitors must be bona fide residents of the State of Texas.



## Horse Validation Information

Horse Validation - Any 4-H member that will be participating in the District and/or State Horse Shows must be validate their horse. Validation should be completed online at [texas.4honline.com](http://texas.4honline.com) (4-H connect).

Validations dates are:    March 1st - April 15th - \$10.00 per horse  
    April 16tyh - May 1st - \$20,00 per horse  
    May 2nd - May 5th - \$250.00 per horse
