Leaders 4 Life (March contest)— Judged on: 1) Performance of Parliamentary Procedure in a mock meeting and leadership skills.

Photography (March contest) Placed depending on creativity and impact in 15 categories.

Educational Presentations (May Contest)— Almost any topic of your interest. Could be in the form of a power point, posters, or demonstration. Needs: Introduction, body of information, summary, and list of resources

Clothing and Textiles:

Fashion Story Board- (April Contest) Drawing of a design you created for: 1) wearable clothing, 2) pet clothing, 3) jewelry, 4) non-wearable: furniture, curtains, etc. **Fashion Show Buying** (April & July Contest)— Poise & interview about what makes a good purchase

Fashion Show Construction (April & July Contest)– Poise & interview explaining garment construction

Duds to Dazzle (April Contest) – Creativity is required to produce a new garment from supplied used items with your team of 3 to 5 members during a set time period

Shooting Sports – (Sept-July) Shotgun, Rifle & Archery-

Various contests and practices for each throughout the year.

Livestock Projects & Shows (All year): Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goats, Rabbits.

Must meet validation dates.

Livestock Judging (Nov./Dec contest, Feb/Mar. contests) – Acquire knowledge for ranking livestock upon their qualities.

Horse Shows/Judging/Quizbowls, Meats Judging, or Wool Judging – (April Contests) Study specifics about each subject and demonstrate knowledge learned in judging contest or quiz bowl format.

SET – Science, Engineering and Technology (May/June Contest)–

Rocket Club, Robotics, and Motion Commotion

Displays: Use scientific method to illustrate subject matter. Categories: Food & Nutrition, Consumer Education, Production Agriculture, Livestock Production, Environment & Natural Resources (including water), Engineering, and Open. The steps are:

- 1. Name the problem or question.
- 2. Form an educated guess (hypothesis) of the cause of the problem and make predictions based upon the hypothesis.
- 3. Test your hypothesis by doing an experiment or study (with proper controls.)
- 4. Check and interpret your results. Report your results to the scientific community.

Healthy Lifestyle Contest—(June) Teams rank best choices of 4 options in categories pertaining to the following subjects: first aid, physical activity, substance abuse, tobacco cessation, passenger safety, teens and safe driving habits, ATV safety, fad diets, altering recipes, food safety, nutrient functions, sports nutrition, hydration, and sun safety. Then they present a solution to a case study.

Leadership Camps (June, July)— Multi-County Camp in Brady, 4-H Congress, District 7 Leadership Lab, County Leadership Lab, Spectra, Brigades, etc

Record books - (June Contest) This is the application for county awards and county council. Great way for members to discover their organizational skills and record their accomplishments to be ready for scholarships when the time comes. 4-Hers who complete a 4-H record book are eligible for the local 4-H Awards, such as the leadership and the star awards. In addition to the top county awards, these books are the foundation to many outstanding scholarships that are won each year by graduating seniors.
