
LIVESTOCK VALIDATION

This year it will be at Fred Nuncio's pens and by appointment. We will be calling you to set up your appointment and give you directions. Your paperwork will be at the Extension Office. You are required to pick it up and have it filled out BEFORE bringing it to VALIDATION. No animal will be unloaded until ALL paperwork is completed first.


