REQUIRED

All applications for any Scholarship are required to turn in a biography. The biography will be read at the 4-H Awards and Recognition Banquet if the member receives one of these awards. The biography should be 200 words or less, written in third person, and describe their 4-H career. Highlights of major projects, life skills learned, or special notes that the member would like to share with the audience should be included. County Extension Agents will edit as needed to fit the format of the banquet.

McLennan 4-H Adult Leaders Association Scholarships

The McLennan 4-H Adult Leaders Association will give scholarships to deserving McLennan County 4-H members. The total amount given each year will be up to \$7,500 split amongst the winners determined by the scholarship committee and Adult Leaders Association.

The purpose of each scholarship is to recognize 4-H members who have been active in the McLennan County 4-H program for at least three years. Selection is based on 4-H experience, needs, and grades. Scholarships will be paid in a one time payment at the beginning of the Fall semester of the winners freshman year after proof of enrollment is presented. Proof of registration should be sent to the McLennan County Extension office. Once this is received, the McLennan Adult Leaders Association Treasurer will forward your scholarship disbursement. Only graduating seniors are eligible for this scholarship.

- Completed Signature form for McLennan Adult Leaders Association Scholarship
- Biography
- Photo of applicant
- Current copy of his/her high school transcript to the county Extension office by the application deadline date.
