All points are due in the Extension Office July 31, for the 2020-2021 year. A brief reminder of points awards:

**High Point Award**—given to a girl and a boy in Junior, Intermediate, and Senior age divisions.

**100 Point Award** - Best Effort Certificate

**150 Point Award**—Members obtaining 150 points will be eligible for a \$60.00 scholarship by the 4-H Parents & Leaders Association. Members who use their scholarship to purchase a jacket will get free monogramming sponsored by the Association.

**\$250.00 Scholarship** - Members getting 150 points each year of High School will be awarded the scholarship.

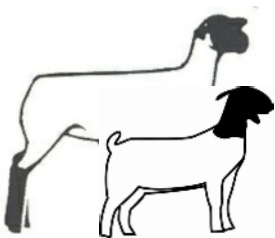
The District 1 Photography Contest does differ from the State Contest as to:

1. Photos may be submitted only one time and in only one category. Photos may not have been entered in any other photography contest including 2021 State Roundup 4-H Photography Contests.
  2. Each youth may only enter up to 3 pictures. This cannot be the same picture manipulated and entered into 3 categories.
  3. Entry fee is \$10.00 for the 1st photo, \$5.00 for the 2nd photo and \$5.00 for the 3rd photo for a total up to \$20.00.
  4. Quality Awards; Blue, Red, White and Green Participation will be given to entries based on the scoring. One Best of Show Award will be presented to one photo in each category per age division. Best of Show photos will be displayed on the District 1 website.
  5. Three lucky people will win a Instant Print Digital Camera! Each youth entered in the District 1 photography contest name will be placed in their corresponding age division.
- Once the contest has been completed three names will be drawn; one junior, one intermediate and one senior.
