#### 15 Entry Deadline for 4-H Photography Contest

Entries for the 4-H Photography Contest will be due to the Extension office ON or BEFORE March 15, 2019. All photographs must have been taken by 4-H members between the dates of January 1, 2018 and the time of entry. Participants will be required to submit a 8X10 photo (for county judging and display) as well as provide a copy of the photo electronically (email or disk). The county contest will follow the guidelines of both the district and state contests with the addition of providing a printed 8X10 copy of the photo. Entries will be broken into **Clover Kids**, Jr., Int. and Sr. age groups.
