## Livestock Checks and Outstanding Fee Bills

Remember the rule that was placed in the Market Livestock Show Rule Book. **Rule #14 states:** If the 4-H or FFA member has charged their feed at the local feed store, then the check will be made payable to the youth **AND** the Feed Store. If all debts are not paid, the child will not be eligible for next year's show.

## Major Show Entry Deadlines

The major show entry deadline is **Friday, November 4, 2016** In order to participate in major shows, you must submit an entry form by this date.
