QUALIFICATIONS

Contestant must be a full-time resident of Rains County and be within the correct age category (**7-9 years**) as of the date of the pageant.

DRESS CODE FOR PAGEANT

Short party dress, short pageant dress, or tea length dress. (Questions, please ask).

NOT CONFORMING TO THE DRESS CODE COULD CAUSE DISQUALIFICATION! Dress length will be left up to the judges' discretion.

DRESS CODE FOR PRELIMINARY JUDGING

Sportswear (Dressy Casual). The contestant will not be allowed to participate in the Preliminary Judging if she comes to the interview in her pageant dress.

MISS PHOTOGENIC

This is an optional category your child may enter. The additional cost to enter is \$25.00, but you will also receive a photo package with 1 - 5x7 and 8 - wallets. The pictures must be made by Deann Dickens of Picture It By D' Photography, 903-474-1170. You must call her by **Friday, August 10, 2018** to schedule your appointment and pay for it the day she takes the picture. The pictures will be taken on **Saturday, August 18, 2018** at Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service office (Hwy 276, across from RYSA Ball Fields). They will be judged by the Pageant Judges the day of the interviews.

REHEARSAL

Tuesday, August 21, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the fairgrounds. A parent or guardian **MUST** be at the practice. If you are not able to attend, please call and let me know.

PRELIMINARY JUDGING

Saturday, September 8, 2018 at the Rains Elementary School. Judging for this age group will begin at **1:00 p.m.** We will begin on time! If the contestant is not ready when the pageant chairman calls for her age group she could be disqualified.

PAGEANT

Thursday, September 13, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

PARADE

Saturday, September 15, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. Line up at **9:30 a.m.** at the lot behind Alco. You can get to it from Honeysuckle Lane. The winner, first, and second runners-up will be in the parade. Furnish your own transportation and two signs on your car with your name and title. If you fail to participate in the parade, you risk being ineligible to participate in future pageants. If you can't be in the parade it must be approved prior to the parade by your pageant chairman.

QUEEN

Saturday, September 15, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. Petite Miss Rains County will help pass out water and snacks to the Rains County Fair Livestock Buyers. Wear your crown and banner and clothing appropriate for the livestock sale, i.e. jeans, nice shirt, and boots. The pageant chairman will supervise your child during this time.

QUEENS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO WEAR THEIR CROWN AND BANNER WHILE SELLING THEIR ANIMAL AT THE RAINS COUNTY FAIR LIVESTOCK SALE.

NOTES

Each contestant will be judged on personality, poise, beauty, posture, and apparel as suited to the individual and their age. All contestants must compete in all areas of the contest and must be able to represent the Fair Association and Rains County at various events throughout the year.
