# Youth Baked Goods Contest Rules

1. The Baked Goods Contest is open to Rains ISD students in Grades Kindergarten - 12th Grade.
  2. Baked goods will be brought in on Tuesday night, September 11, 2018 in the Creative Arts Building Demonstration Kitchen Area between 6:00 P.M. and 6:30 P.M.
  3. There will be three age categories: Juniors: Kindergarten - 2nd Grade, Intermediates: 3rd - 5th Grade and Seniors: 6th - 12th Grades.
  4. Exhibits will be numbered at check in. No names will be presented before the judges.
  5. Judging will begin at 7:00 P.M. You may stay and watch the judging, but **NO TALKING** to the judges will be allowed.
  6. Awards will be presented following the judging.
  7. Baked goods must have been cooked by the exhibitor, but may have had assistance if exhibitor is a youth.
  8. All entries must have been made within 2 days prior to the contest date. All entries must be baked. **No-Bake items will not be allowed,**
  9. The recipe must accompany each entry. It must be typed or neatly printed on a 3 X 5 index card and attached to the entry. We reserve the right to print recipes in the newspaper.
  10. Exhibits must be presented on disposable plates and covered with clear wrap.
  11. Exhibits must have 3 pieces on the plate: cookies, candy, slices of bread, cake or pie.
  12. No mixes will be accepted, except as **part** of the recipe.
  13. Exhibitor must not have entered the same recipe in any previous Rains County Fair Baked Goods Contest.
  14. All exhibits will be tasted by the judges.
  15. Judging Criteria: appearance, texture, doneness, and taste.
  16. Awards: 1st through 5th Place will be awarded a ribbon in each of the classes. A Grand and Reserve Champion winner will be selected from the blue ribbon winners in each age group.
