Each year, Randall County 4-H and FFA Youth Livestock exhibitors have the opportunity to apply to be a Randall County Junior Livestock Ambassador. A total of **15** Ambassadors will be selected by application and interview process.

Ambassadors will serve as junior leaders and will assist show and auction sale officials during this year's **70th** Annual Randall County Junior Livestock Show set for January 16-22, 2018. Criteria for Junior Ambassador include:

- 1) Must have exhibited livestock at the RCJL Show at least one year
- 2) Must be a member of either or both 4-H or FFA and be entered as an exhibitor for the 2018 RCJL Show
- 3) Must submit an application by <u>5 p.m. Friday 3, 2017</u> and BE PRESENT FOR AN INTERVIEW between 4-6 p.m. Monday November 13, 2017
- 4) Must attend <u>50%</u> or more of your 4-H or FFA Chapter meetings. Your Club Leader or Ag. Teacher must verify this by signing your application
- 5) Be willing to serve in a leadership role assisting show officials during the show and auction sale
- 6) Be prepared to promote the 2018 RCJL Show at any time to civic clubs, TV, radio and newspaper
- 7) Wear Ambassador uniform during the entire RCJL Show (except while you are showing) and auction sale.

This is a youth leadership opportunity that is directly associated with the Randall County Junior Livestock Show. Applications must be submitted to CEA or Ag. Science Teacher. However, ALL applications must be received at the Extension office by 5pm <u>Friday, November 3, 2017</u>. All potential candidate interviews will be held on <u>Monday, November 13, 2017</u> starting at 4 p.m. A three-judge panel will interview each applicant with questions that primarily pertain to your livestock experience, what you've learned and various leadership roles you have held. Each interview is scheduled for 10 minutes; however most will not run that long.

If you choose to submit an application, please call the Randall County Extension Office at 468-5543 to schedule your interview time on or before **<u>5pm. Friday</u>**, **<u>November 3, 2017</u>**. In the event of a school conflict, or family emergency conflicting with interview time, you may submit a video. Videos must be submitted to the County Extension Office by **<u>5pm Thursday</u>**, **<u>November 9, 2017</u>**, and must cover questions listed on the application.
