About 4-H

WELCOME RANDALL COUNTY 4-H!

4-H is a program for youth who are 8 years of age and have entered the third grade. There is a Club for everyone to join and a variety of Projects for members to participate in.

The first step in joining 4-H, is to choose a club your interested in. There are no restrictions to which club you can join, for club related questions- contact the Club Manager. Clubs meet monthly from September to May and Projects take place throughout certain times of the year, for Project related questions- contact the Project Leader.

The next step in joining 4-H is to enroll online through 4-H online by create a family profile. You can then add member(s), pay the enrollment fee and once approved by county office, register for contests and events. The membership enrollment fee is \$25 each year, if you enroll by October 31. The fee increases to \$30 through the remainder of the 4-H year.

We provide a non-competitive program for youth in grades K-2nd called, Clover Kids. As a Clover Kid, youth will attend monthly meetings that are centered around fun, learning activities. There is no participation fee for Clover Kids.

FAST FACTS

- You will need to re-enroll each year starting on September 1. Your family profile information will "roll over," however, you will be required to pay the annual membership fee and update your family and member(s) information.
- The County office will approve membership enrollment and event/contest registrations
- You are an official 4-H member when your status is ACTIVE on your member profile
- Adult Volunteers are required to be screened through Sterling Volunteers every three years.
