

2019 SCJLS Rule Changes and Updates

Date of Show: April 4-6, 2019

Changes and Clarifications:

General Rule # 2: ...Any and all projects may be used at the discretion of the SCJLS Board for judging contests after 3:00pm on Friday.

General Rule #3: All divisions of the SCJLS are open to all 4H, FFA, and FCCLA members in good standing.

General Rule #7: Any unruly, unfit, or diseased animals will not be allowed to show and need to be removed from the Show grounds.

General Rule #16: The act of forced feeding and/or forced watering is only allowed using a drench gun and only in the cheek of the animal.

Market Rule # 8: All projects sold, and Add-Ons, will have an 8% commission taken out...

Market Rule #18: Only when Grand and Reserve Grand are shown by the same exhibitor will there not be a Reserve Champion project of that show in the Sale Order.

Market Rabbit Division #4: ... rabbits with tattoos already in place will not be validated.

Roaster and Broilers Divisions: No wing bands are required.

Updates:

1. Heifers may be brought in anytime Thursday or Friday morning before check in time on Friday.

2. Rabbits will have a Pre-judging /Sift
3. Rabbit judging will be in a designated area with only the Exhibitor, one at a time.
4. Rabbits should be ordered by each Exhibitor. The Ag. Teachers or 4H Leaders may find a breeder to suggest or order from. The County Agent is NOT responsible for ordering rabbits.
5. Market Ready weights is added to all market animal divisions.
6. There is an entry fee increase to \$20 for all animal projects & Ag. Mechanics. \$10 for Horticulture, and \$5 for Home Ec.
7. There will be a recordbook award for Commercial Heifers.
8. One Animal Disposition form for EACH animal project. These will be given at check-in.
9. Entry Forms MUST BE SIGNED when turned in.
10. No canned food drive.
11. No Buyers' Gifts.
12. Superintendents need to send a list of all exhibitors/entries checked in for shows not broken by weights to the Livestock office before beginning their shows.
13. Superintendents will be given a check list and a list of ribbons/awards for their show and how they are designated.
