Compared to last week, all the front-end classes of feeder steers and heifer averages from 500 lbs and down ended fully \$2 to \$3 higher while the weight class averages over 500 lbs showed to be from \$1 - \$2 lower.

Slaughter cow figures remained firm while the slaughter bulls finished about \$3 stronger. Still wet conditions in the feedlots plus today's negative feeder board closing continue to be a price factor but lower market n are keeping the feeder calve figures decent .
