**Compared to last week: all feeder steer and heifer weight class price averages ended Mostly firm on the front-end classes yet the plainer classes continued to feel demand pressure and And ended fully \$2 to \$5 lower.**

**Slaughter cows and slaughter bulls continue to be on the mend as prices improved fully \$2 higher. Stocker cows also remain in good demand as pastures continue to improve.**

**Today's board closing witnessed both live and feeder cattle futures up for all months.**

**Today's market was proof that there continues to remain a sizable gap in prices between the front-end classes and the plainer, hard to place feeder calves.**
