Summary

Compared to last week: all feeder and heifer weight class price averages ended fully \$1.50 to \$4.00 higher.

Slaughter cows and bulls remain under pressure with ending figures around \$3 to \$5 Lower

With yesterday's strong board closing, today's ending figures were again a mixture of green and red with most of the red favoring the feeder contracts. Buyer aggression appeared to mostly ignore the weakened board as they competed with strong figures.

Slaughter figures continue to remain under pressure as drying conditions are allowing more cull animals to be marketed.

Next Week: 10 Black Angus Bulls With Papers Available on Most by Buyer Request. All bulls are virgins with both Trich and Fertility Test. Bulls are from 24 to 30 months old.
