Compared to last week: All weight class averages of feeder steers and heifers ended fully \$4 to \$8 lower. Slaughter cows and slaughter bulls finished firm to \$1 higher.

Buyers were working against a negative feeder board closing along with seasonal weather changes coming. Cooler nights along with hot days create havoc on animal health as feeder buyers gear up with softer market demand and lower price adjustments. Although active, the market showed an undertone.
