With no market comparison due to last week's Thanksgiving Holiday shutdown, today's market figures compared to the pre-shutdown showed all weight class price averages ended fully \$2 to \$4 higher. Slaughter cows and slaughter bulls also trended \$2 higher. Stronger figures showed up last week as fat cattle moved into the \$1.17 to \$1.20 arena. Optimism from this along with the northern wheat fields growing along with excellent weather is helping fuel buyer interest as we near the years end. Buyers continue to be aggressive yet cautious in their quality purchases. The price difference gap between the front-end calves and plainer remains large.
