Compared to last week's market; feeder steers and heifers class averages weighing 500 lbs and down ended from \$2 to \$4 higher while those classes over 500 lbs weakened from \$2 to \$5. Slaughter cows were \$3 stronger while the slaughter bulls finished \$5 stronger.

Today's mixed board closing had little bearing on the market but the cold front bringing ice and snow to the feedlot regions within the next few days has dampened buyer aggression. The Coronavirus Virus spreading from China also has affected the financial markets including the futures board.
