Compared to last week: the front-end of both feeder steers and heifer class averages ended from \$3 to \$7 weaker while those plainer, hard to place feeder calves averages ended from \$7 to \$12 lower. Slaughter cows weakened around \$4 while the slaughter bulls finished some \$4 higher. Demand was decent on the better classes with today's quality offering being somewhat lower.

The livestock futures along with the stock market continues on its pendulum path forcing traders to remain extremely cautious. Hopefully this pandemic fear will subside soon allowing this country to return to its normalcy and allowing the markets to regain a steady course.
