Compared to last week: all weight classes of both feeder steers and heifers price averages ended mostly steady on the front-end classes but \$4 to \$6 lower on the plainer, hard to place feeder calves. Slaughter cows and slaughter bulls today ended firm to \$2 lower on lighter yielding carcasses.

The feeder board continues to show volatility as the packing plants are running around 65% of normal slaughter rates causing a huge backlog of live cattle that are still waiting in the feedlots to be processed. The pressure on the market continues to mount.

Our market had good activity on all classes. The heavy calves are under pressure as the feed yards are backed up with ready to harvest cattle. On a positive note, about 30,000 more feedlot cattle were killed this week compared to a week ago, but still 200,000 less than the same week a year ago.
