Compared to last week: all classes of feeder steers and heifer price averages weighing from 400 lbs and down ended from \$3 to \$5 lower while feeder steers and heifers over 400 lbs finished \$2 to \$4 higher. The slaughter cow and bulls figures today gave into pressure and ended \$3 to \$5 lower as some drought areas are forcing more numbers to markets.

We are beginning to see the marketing numbers pick up but increasing and expanding drought areas in the grazing country could well have a impact on future market prices.
