Where do I start?

- **How to show an animal at the County Fair or the Major Shows:**

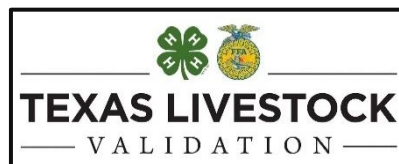
- In order to show, you will need to “validate” or “tag-in” your animal.
- What is “**validation**”? (For the Major Shows)



- The process of establishing a permanent identity of the animal and to verify the ownership by the 4-H member(s) for the Major Shows.
- A date set by the Waller County Livestock Show Validation Committee to administer the validation process.
- Emails will be sent with deadlines to place your order for validation materials for state validation. Dates are also posted in the 4-H newsletter, in the newspapers, and on Facebook.

- What is a “**Tag-In**”? (For the Waller County Fair)

- A date set by the Waller County Fair Office to put tags in the animal’s ear.
- “Tag-Ins” are held between April and June (depending on animal species). Dates will be published in the 4-H newsletter or you can check the Waller County Fair website. <https://wallercountyfair.org/>



- **Waller County Fair**

- You do not have to order tags ahead of time (except poultry). You can just show up to your “Tag-In” date for your animal species.
 - Turkey/Broiler order nights are in the spring (check for deadlines).
- All rules are on the fair website. <https://wallercountyfair.org/>
- Meeting dates and tag-ins are set by the Waller County Fair Species Committee/Chairperson.

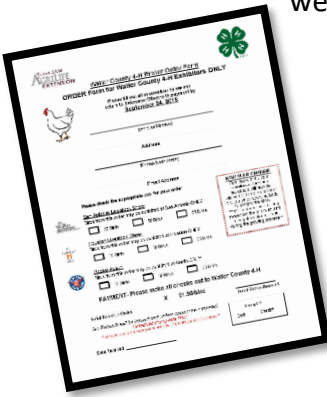

• Major Shows

- **Fall Shows:** State Fair of Texas and Heart O' Texas
- **Spring Shows:** Fort Worth, San Angelo, San Antonio, Houston, Austin and Rio Grande Valley
- Visit our website for important information and forms

- **Validation tag order forms and deadlines** will be posted in the 4-H newsletter, on our website and on our Facebook page.



- Validation dates are based on the show and animal species.
 - **June Validations**
 - Steers and heifers (for all Major Shows)
 - Lambs, pigs and goats (for State Fair and Heart O' Texas only)
 - **October Validations**
 - Heifers, lambs, goats and pigs (for Spring Major Shows-**NOT** State Fair and Heart O' Texas)
- State Fair and Heart O' Texas entry forms are due in August
- Fort Worth, San Angelo, San Antonio, Houston, Austin and Rio Grande entry forms are due in November.
- Broilers/Turkeys
 - Order forms for State Fair are due in June
 - Order forms for San Antonio, Houston and Austin are due in September

○ **Quality Counts Training**
