Swine Showmanship Tips



- 1. Dress appropriately
- 2. Be ready to enter the ring when your class is called
- 3. Know where the judge is at all times
- 4. Know how to use your show stick properly
- 5. Condition your pig to be used to the show stick
- 6. Keep a small brush in your pocket to remove dirt that may get on your pig
- 7. Drive your pig gently at the front flank
- 8. Never hit your pig excessively in the ring
- 9. Keep your pig between you and the judge
- 10. Keep your pig 10 to 15 feet away from the judge
- 11. Stay out of large groups of pigs and exhibitors
- 12. Keep your pig out of the corners
- 13. Keep your pig walking and moving
- 14. Show the judge each of the different angles of your pig
- 15. If you are selected to be penned raise your hand so ring stewards know where you are
- 16. If you are selected to be penned start working your pig that direction, don't wait
- 17. Always be ready to answer questions (especially in showmanship classes!)
- 18. Have a good attitude
- 19. Be courteous to other exhibitors
