Criteria:

- Any Washington County 4-H member who is a high school senior
- Have been an active member of 4-H for the past three years and completed a record book each of those years
- Be active in church and in community affairs
- Be planning to pursue a degree in an accredited college, university, or technical school for any course of study

Complete and turn in the following:

- Washington EEA 4-H Scholarship Information Form
- Personal Essay
- Official high school transcript with ACT and/or SAT scores included
- Two letters of recommendation: one from a county Extension Agent or 4-H club manager and one from a teacher, employer, or community leader (not relative)
- Submit the previous year's 4-H record book to the County Extension Office by date to be announced (Usually the middle of February)
- Participate in a personal interview conducted by the Washington County Extension Education 4-H Scholarship Committee on date to be announced

The following criteria will be used to determine the recipients:

- 4-H Experience/Projects (35 pts)
- 4-H Leadership, Citizenship, & Community Service (30 pts)
- 4H Honors (15 pts)
- High School Transcript with ACT and/or SAT scores (10 pts)
- Outside 4-H Leadership, Honors, Work Experience, Volunteer/Community Service (10 pts)
