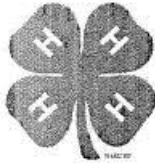

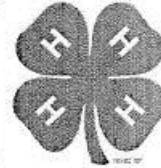

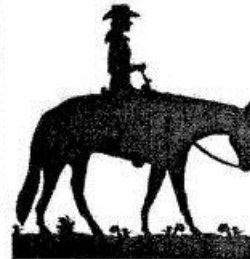

# 2015 Texas 4-H Roundup VETERINARY SCIENCE SUMMER CAMP

College Station, TX | June 8 - 11

The goal of the Texas 4-H Veterinary Science camp is to provide experiential learning opportunities for students participating in the Veterinary Science Certificate Program (VSCP) where they can learn basic clinical skills for small animal and large animal veterinary medicine under the direction of a veterinarian. This camp will allow participants to complete 33 of the 78 clinical skills hours required for the VSCP and certification process.

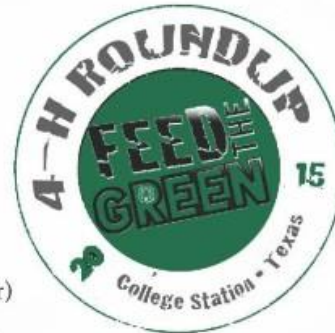
