PROCESS OF SUBMITTING PHOTOGRAPHS FOR COUNTY JUDGING All entries for the 2015 Williamson County 4-H Photography Contest will be completed using an online entry method. Please read the following submission rules very careful to prevent disqualification of entries!

Please read these rules very carefully and follow every step correctly !!!

- 1. Formatting the Photograph. Photographs should be taken at the highest resolution possible. Photographs must be in a .jpeg, .jpg, or .gif format. Files submitted may not be larger than 2,048k(2MB). There is no minimum size requirement, however, your photograph must be large enough that it can be evaluated for the contest. (i.e. if it is too small, it can be disqualified).
- Labeling/Naming the Photograph. Each photograph will need to be clearly labeled with the Age Division, Category, County, 4-H member's first and last name and the name of the category (see below for label name).
