WILLIAMSON COUNTY LIVESTOCK ASSOCIATION
SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

1. Scholarships will be awarded annually with amount varying each year. The number of scholarships awarded and the amount of each scholarship will depend on number of graduating seniors, returning college students and availability of funds.
2. Each student receiving a scholarship will be able to use monies at a college, university, or technical school of their choice.
3. Students must have been enrolled in 4-H / FFA for a minimum of 1 year and must be involved in other community service projects and non-school activities. Returning college students need to fill out what applies to them.
4. All applicants must submit the following:
 - a. Scholarship application
 - b. High School/ College transcript
 - c. Letters of recommendation from:
 1. 4-H Leader/FFA Teacher/Professor
 2. Community or school leader
5. Scholarship will be announced at recipients High School graduation, annual 4-H awards banquet or WCLA Meeting.
6. Before receiving scholarship, recipient must submit proof of school registration, social security number, name and address of financial aid office/director at school they will be attending. These items must be submitted 30 days prior to when recipient needs scholarship. All scholarship monies will be mailed directly to the financial aid office and will be distributed through them. Any monies left over or refunded will remain in student's scholarship account at school or be returned to WCLA.
7. The intent of the Williamson County Livestock Association Scholarship is to provide an equal amount awarded to equally qualified applicants. Qualified is considered a good 4-H/FFA learning experience and an appropriately completed application. Unqualified applications are those that have not demonstrated 4-H/FFA learning experiences, and have not adequately completed the scholarship application. A scholarship committee consisting of at least one WCLA Board Member will judge the applications. The decision made by the committee will be final. Due to limitation of available funds, some technically qualified applicants may not receive a scholarship. Final decisions regarding scholarship recipients and the amount of each scholarship are in the sole discretion of the scholarship committee.
8. Money **must** be claimed **within 2 years** of being awarded to recipient.
