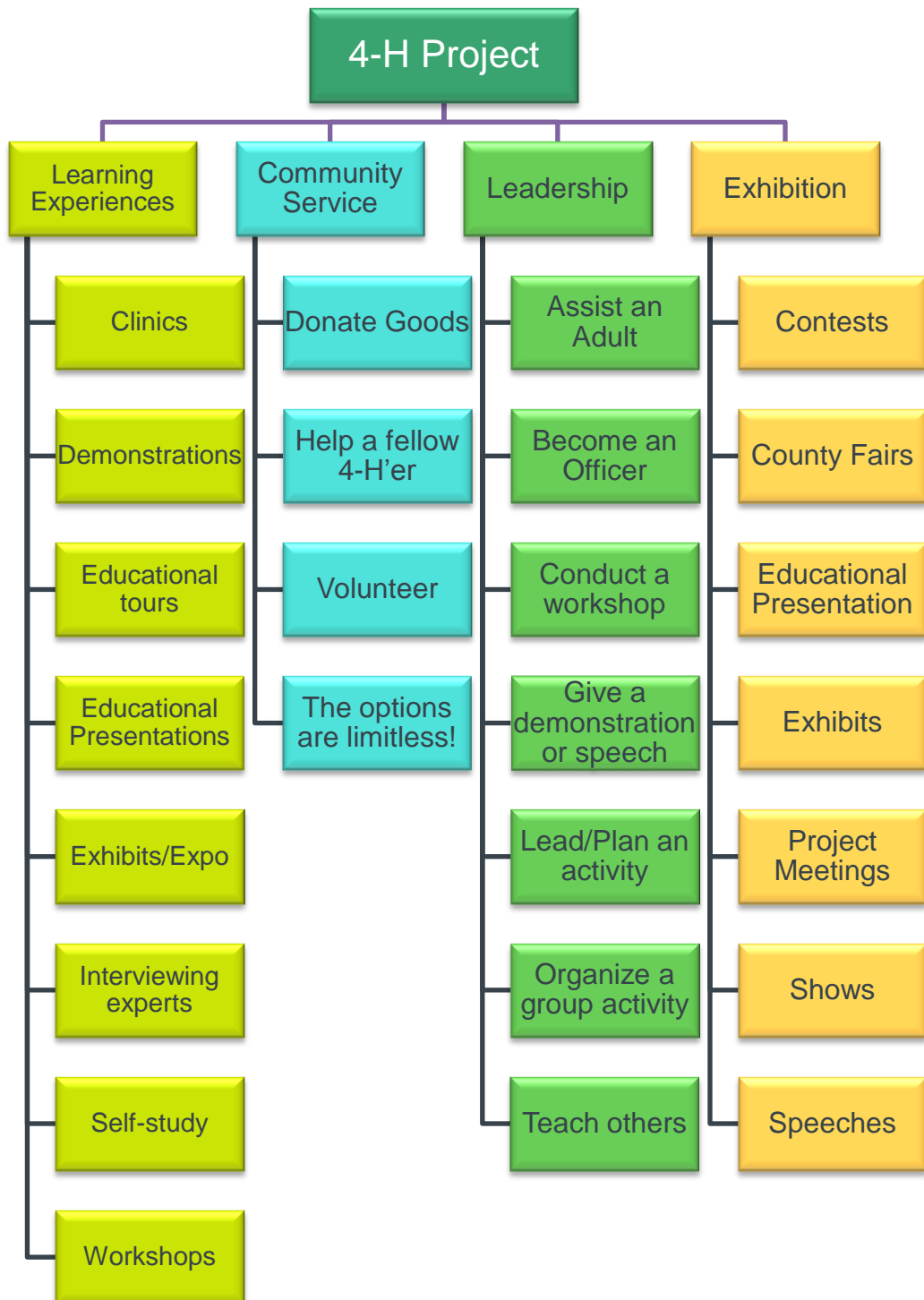




# What is a 4-H Project?

# What is a 4-H Project?

## When should I do my 4-H Project?

- 4-H projects should be completed within the 4-H Project year, however, there is no set timeline within the year. Work at your own pace!

## Where can I find help?

- Support comes from 4-H Project Leaders, Club Managers, and fellow 4-H members. If you need help in a specific project area you can also look for resources such as...

  - ✓ Hobbyists

## How many learning experiences should I have?

- A 4-H project should consist of at least 6 different learning experiences that are 20-60 minutes long.

## Do I have to compete with my 4-H project?

- Nope! You can exhibit your 4-H project in other ways like for instance giving a presentation or speech at your 4-H club meeting.
